 - 3. FIGHTING GOD'S CAUSE WHEN ATTACKED
- 4. PROTECTION OF FAITH AND SELF, FAMILY AND PROPERTY
 - 5. NON-COMMITAL OF AGGRESSION (GOD-DOES NOT LOVE AGGRESSORS)
 - 6. <u>CESSESSION OF FIGHTING, IMMEDIATELY</u> AGGRESSORS CEASE HOSTILITY
 - 7. IN GENERAL THE PROPHET'S POLICY WAS TO AVOID WAR AND SETTLE DIPLOMATIC RESOLUTIONS, WHICH IS DISCLOSED IN HIS NUMEROUS TREATIES. MOST OF HIS BATTLES WERE OF DEFENSIVE NATURE, OR CONSTITUTED A PREEMPTIVE OFFENSIVE TO BREAK THE STRENGTH AND AVOID THE ATTACK OF BELLIGERENTS.
